As a teacher specialising in Infant and Primary School Education, and qualified in Audiovisual Communication, I consider Títiris a good product to help children learn to use information and communications technology for themselves. It is aimed directly at children, but at the same time takes into account the roles of parents and teachers as companions and educators.

At school, it is a good computer tool to backup what children have been taught. It is very easy to use, which means children can practise and reinforce what they have learnt on their own.

Títiris have increased their range with a new audiovisual product. In **DVD** format, it is **easy to use** at home, giving children the opportunity to learn **by themselves but at the same time allowing parents** to accompany them and interact with them in this educational process.

Following my first pedagogical review, I consider the structure of the programme makes it very easy for both children and adults to use.

The presentation of the product includes a file directed exclusively at the educator, which explains how the programme works and lays out the objectives and content.

In the **songs** section the **words have been included**, which is ideal, as it provides information for the **adult** and, more importantly, for the **children** who are beginning to read. **It is not intended to be a form of karaoke**, as highlighting the text might cause anxiety in the children.

The presentation of the **stories** is easy to identify, as **each one has its own melody**. The volume can be turned off, in order to do alternative creative activities, and the story can be explained orally with the help of the **short sentences**, related to the images, **which motivate the child to read**.

The games section allows the introduction of more educational content and, at the same time, is the children's favourite. The way a child learns to read has been taken into account in the design of the games, and this makes them easy to use.
